**Brief Description of Program:**

This purpose of the program is to provide Federal assistance to States to establish, develop, update, or upgrade: (1) computerized identification systems that are compatible and integrated with the database of the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) at the FBI; (2) the capacity to analyze deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) in a forensic laboratory in ways that are compatible with the combined DNA Identification Systems (CODIS) of the FBI; and (3) automated fingerprint identification systems that are compatible and integrated with the Integrated Automation Fingerprint Identification System (IAFIS) of the FBI.
