Town of Pikeville FYE June 30, 2022 Proposed Budget Ordinance Presented June 22, 2021

BE IT ORDAINED by the NC Local Government Commission acting in place of the Board of Commissioners for the Town of Pikeville, North Carolina pursuant to NC General Statute 159-181(c):

Section 1. The following amounts are hereby appropriated for the operation of the Town's Government and its activities for the fiscal year (FY) beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, according to the following schedules:

<u>Section 3</u>. That the tax rate of \$0.69 is hereby levied on each one hundred dollars (\$100) valuation of taxable property, as listed for taxes as of January 1, 2021, for the purpose of raising revenue from property taxes as set forth in the foregoing revenue estimate, and in order to finance the General Fund's appropriations for the general expenses incidental to the proper government of the Town.

This rate of tax is based on an estimated total appraised valuation of property for the purpose of taxation of \$43,527,212 and an estimated rate of collection of ninety-eight and six-hundreths percent (98.06%)

Section 4: The Secretary of the Local Government Commission and the Finance Officer are hereby authorized to (a) take any actions and to (b) execute and deliver any contract, agreement, and any other document on behalf of the Local Government Commission that may be necessary, appropriate or desirable for the purpose of collecting District receipts and expending appropriations from all funds.

Section 5: Copies of this Budget Ordinance shall be furnished to the Secretary of the Local Government Commission and to the Finance Officer to be kept on file by them for their direction in the disbursement of funds.
