Brief Description of Program:

Grants will be awarded based on their relevancy to the powers and duties outlined in NC General Statute § 20-7.6. "Awarding grants-in-aid to non-profit entities to conduct education and awareness activities on organ and tissue donation and advance care planning." Grants will be considered for but are not limited to the following areas as they relate to the purposes stated above:

- Implementing general education and community outreach.
- Targeting education to multicultural populations.
- Supporting partnerships committed to organizational and community change.
- Collaborating between agencies and organizations that develop statewide initiatives for change.
- Networking with other foundations, trusts, and commissions to enhance the overall outcomes of this funding.

Types of eligible non-profit entities might include but are not limited to Organ Procurement Organizations, Tissue Banks, Eye Banks, Coalitions on Donation, Advance Care Planning and End-of-Life Organizations, Schools, Colleges and Universities, Civic Organizations, Faith Communities, Museums and Libraries.

The process for applicants requesting grants-in-aid is done in three phases: Letter of Intent; Full Application & Agreement and Release of Funds.

After the final selection is made, each sub-recipient must execute a State of North Carolina Contract before receiving the approved amount of grants-in-aid.

Expenditures or outlays from state grant funds shall not exceed the budgeted amounts for each line item or for the total grant. Allowable costs are Personnel, Travel, Supplies, Equipment, Advertising, Printing, Copying and Postage, Other cost such as Accounting, SWIPE to Donate app, Communications and Public Outreach Software Services.
