## Brief Description of Program:

The Division disburses receipt funds to each local health department as required in NCGS 130A-248(d) on an annual basis for support of local food, lodging, and institutions permitting and inspection programs. Funding is based upon program inspection compliance percentages and base rate. Funds may be utilized by the local health departments to administer state regulation activities related to state authorized agent performance of food, lodging, and institutional sanitation inspection activities. Such activities include educating staff, salary adjustments, computer hardware/software, clerical support, audiovisual aids and equipment, technical journal subscriptions, reference books, and necessary technical equipment related to food, lodging and institutional sanitation programs.
