Kevin SigRist was named Chief Investment Officer of the Investment Management Division at the NC Department of State Treasurer in December 2012. Previously, he served as Deputy Executive Director of the State Board of Administration in Florida, and has served in various capacities with the Florida investment fund, including Senior Investment Officer and Chief of Client Services & Enterprise Risk Management.
